Guardians of the Central Coast

U.S. Coast Guard Station Monterey is home to two 47-foot Motor Lifeboats, and one 29-foot response boat. The more than 40 member crew who serve here carry out search and rescue, homeland security, marine environmental protection, and maritime law enforcement missions. Additionally, the Station Monterey crew works closely with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, Fish and Wildlife, Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary, and local fire and police departments. The unit's area of responsibility extends 50 miles offshore from the San Mateo County line south to the San Luis Obispo County line.
